Guinea As of 17 April 2014, a cumulative total of 202 clinically compatible cases of Ebola virus disease (EVD) including 125 deaths were reported from 5 districts and the capital Conakry. Of the reported cases, 108 were laboratory confirmed.

6 patients suspected to have a viral haemorrhagic fever were all test negative.

- Contact tracing, Public health awareness and psychological support are ongoing
